

ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

- Class sizes are small with up to 9 two year olds, 9 three year olds, and 11 Pre-Kindergarten students.
- Our average teacher/student ratio is 1:6.
- All lead teachers have early childhood education and experience.
- All staff take a minimum of 15 hours of continuing education each year.
- All staff is trained in CPR and First Aid.
- We provide a healthy snack for all children.
- Activity and behavior notes are sent home daily with each child.
- Each month parents are given a snack calendar along with a newsletter and activity calendar.
- We generally follow the Fayette County Public Schools' calendar.
- Progress reports are sent home twice a year. Conferences are held each spring.

ADMISSION POLICY

The BLC two year old program is open to children who will be 2 by August 1; they do not have to be toilet trained to be in this class. The children in the three year old class and Pre-K must be 3 or 4 by August 1 and, in the absence of a special need, must be toilet trained. We will need a current copy of your child's immunization record and health insurance card at the time of enrollment.

FEES

An annual non-refundable registration fee of \$85.00 is required upon enrollment. There is a discount for Beaumont Presbyterian Church members. Tuition is due the first school day of each month. A late fee will be charged after the tenth of the month. No deductions will be made for the absence of a child. Two weeks' notice is required if a child leaves the program for any reason. The cost for one year of school is divided into ten monthly payments for your convenience. There is also a Materials/Snack fee of \$40.00 per semester.

3. Become aware that each person is responsible to show kindness and respect to others.
4. Develop an ability to communicate appropriately with teachers and peers.
5. Have opportunities to learn about art, music, science, math, reading and writing.

- Development of gross and small motor skills

- Teachers will work with you on toilet training

THREE YEAR OLD CLASS

- Meets Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon
- Nine children and two staff
- Theme based learning
- Development of gross and small motor skills
- Introduce academic skills
- Learning through circle time activities, learning centers, outdoor/indoor free play, story, music, and art
- In the absence of a special need, children must be toilet trained

PRE- KINDERGARTEN CLASS

- Meets Mondays through Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon
- Eleven children and two staff
- Theme based learning
